Summer Fun Basics

Our Summer Fun program is open to all youth regardless of prior experience with 4-H.

Youth must be enrolled in 4-H Online (v2.4honline.com) before registering for Summer Fun activities. This enrollment does not mean they have to participate in any other 4-H activities. This is for the safety of all participants. If you have enrollment questions please call our office at 336-753-6100. We will work with you if you cannot complete the online enrollment.

Our programs depend greatly on our volunteers. So we would like to say "Thank You" to all current volunteers. If you would like to volunteer or be present during a program with your child, please contact our office so we can make notes for the volunteer leaders.

INFORMATION

Registration:

All programs this year are limited to 10 participants. Registration is open to all Davie County youth. For all ages listed, the participant must be that age as of January 1, 2021, to comply with NC 4-H regulations. Registration takes place at N.C. Cooperative Extension, Davie County Center, at 180 S. Main St., Mocksville, NC 27028 from 8:30 am to 4:30 pm. (the red brick building next to the courthouse). **No registration will be taken over the phone**, but we will be happy to answer any questions you may have by calling 336-753-6100. If it is not possible for you to register in person, please mail in the REGISTRATION page with a check made payable to Davie County 4-H. No registration will be processed before Tuesday, April 27, 2021. Forms will be processed as we receive them. If you do not receive confirmation within two (2) weeks, please notify our office.

4-H Online:

Before completing registration, parents should determine the enrollment status of the participant. You can find this enrollment at v2.4honline.com. **Online enrollment is required before registering for Summer Fun.** In 4-H Online you will read the 4-H Code of Conduct and Disciplinary Procedure, please review this document. This document explains how youth are expected to behave while participating in all 4-H activities, including Summer Fun. If necessary disciplinary action will take place, and if action is not corrected, a parent/guardian will be called to pick up the participant.

Fees:

The fee for each class covers all expenses including transportation, insurance, program cost, and snack when appropriate, unless otherwise stated in the description. **Refunds will only be made if the class is cancelled by Davie County 4-H. Only checks and exact change are accepted. We cannot accept debit/credit cards, and we do not keep cash in our office.**

Times and Locations:

Activities will be held at the Davie County Center Meeting Room unless otherwise stated. **All offsite trips will depart from and return to the County Center. A parent/guardian MUST accompany the participant into the building and sign the participant in, leave an emergency contact, and indicate who will be picking the participant up. A parent/guardian MUST also come in to sign the participant out.** We promise to be as prompt as possible for returning to the County Center. We expect the same of parents/guardians. For the safety of your child, as well as consideration for our staff and instructors, please do not bring your child more than **10 minutes** early and pick them up on time.

Additional Information:

- Masks Required at all events and programs.
- A cooler will be provided when participants are asked to bring a bag lunch.
- Please **DO NOT** send electronic devices or other valuables, including cell phones.
- If participants choose to bring money for souvenirs they are responsible for that money and any purchases made.
- If your child has any special needs, please contact the County Center upon registration or at least two weeks prior to the activity. Every effort will be made to accommodate special needs if adequate notification is given.

Cost: \$60

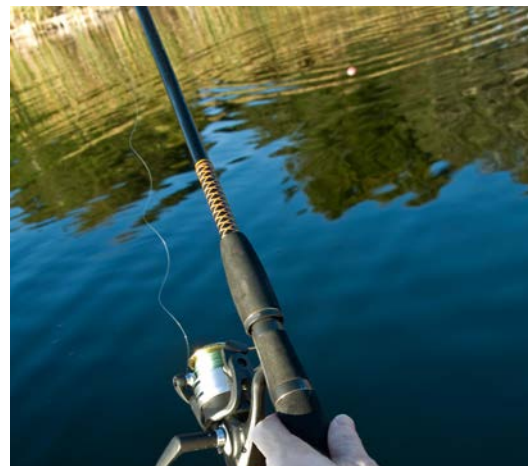

Please wear closed-toe shoes, and clothes that can get dirty. Wear sunscreen. Bring a water bottle. Masks Required.

Description: Join Davie County Master Gardener Volunteers for a week of hands-on gardening activities and education. Youth will learn about insects, including bees and other beneficials; learn about plant growth and development; and take part in gardening activities. They will also learn about composting and recycling, visit a local farm (weather permitting), and much more. Parents are invited to join us at noon on Friday for a graduation ceremony.



Freshwater Exploration Camp

Date: June 14-18

Age as of January 1, 2021: 8 - 18 yrs. old

Cost: \$25

Times: M - F: 8am - 12pm

Location: Davie County Center (180 S. Main St.
Mocksville, NC 27028) and local parks

Other Info: Bring a bag lunch, Sun protection (sunscreen, hat, etc.), water shoes (or shoes that can get dirty), bug spray, water bottle, and clothes that can get dirty. Personal fishing gear can also be brought. Masks Required.

Description: Get ready to learn about the world of Davie County creeks, rivers, and ponds! Participants will get to explore local creeks, learn about the importance of clean water, conduct cool science experiments, and get to do some fishing along the way. No fishing knowledge is required. Participants are welcome to bring their own fishing gear but we will also provide rods and tackle as well. We will be near bodies of water in this camp and participants should know about the risks involved with doing water activities.

Farm to Table

Date: June 28-29

Age as of January 1, 2021: 9 - 12 yrs old

Cost: FREE

Times: 8:30 am - 3 pm

Location: Davie County Center (180 S. Main St., Mocksville, NC 27028), Davie Cognition, as well as local farms.

Other Info: Lunch included. Please wear closed-toe shoes and clothes that can get dirty. Pack sun protection (sunscreen, hat, etc.) and a water bottle. Masks Required.

Description: Come learn about the process from the Farm to Your Table! Participants will visit local farms and do activities to learn where your delicious food actually comes from. Food doesn't magically appear on the grocery store shelf and youth will be actively involved in plant agriculture and learn about animal agriculture. Participants need to wear closed-toe shoes suitable for farm visits. Program sponsored by Davie County Farm Bureau.



Zoo Trip

Date: June 30

Age as of January 1, 2021: 5 - 18 yrs old

Cost: \$30

Times: 8 am - 4 pm

Location: North Carolina Zoo (4401 Zoo Pkwy, Asheboro, NC 27205) **Participants will be picked up and dropped off at the County Center.**

Other Info: Bring Bag Lunch. Wear closed-toe shoes and comfortable clothes. Pack sun protection (sunscreen, hat, etc.) and water bottle. Masks Required.

Description: It's going to be a Wild Time! We are excited to announce our Davie County 4-H Annual Zoo Trip on June 30. We will get to learn about the animals that inhabit NC Zoo and learn about ways to conserve them in the wild. We will be taking a tour bus, so please arrive at our office (180 S. Main St. Mocksville, NC 27028) NO LATER THAN 8 AM to board the bus and prepare for the trip to the zoo. We will arrive back at the office by 4pm.

Basic Firearms Safety and Skills

Date: July 2

Age as of January 1, 2021: 8 - 18 yrs old

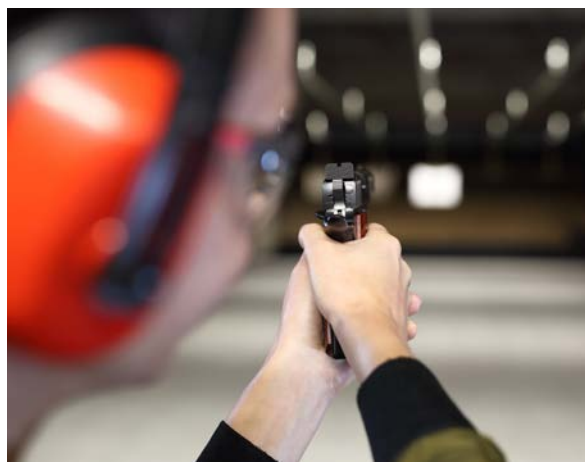
Cost: \$10

Location: Tom Cowden Shooting Sports Range (210 Amberhill Road, Mocksville, NC 27028) **Participants will be picked up and dropped off at the County Center.**

Other Info: Bring Bag Lunch. Wear closed-toe shoes and comfortable clothes. Masks Required.

Description: Participants will learn and practice firearm safety while learning the fundamentals of rifle shooting with .22 rifles. They will also learn and practice with Shotguns during this workshop. Smaller youth should be cautious as recoil from shotguns can be more wearing. Participants will shoot targets of various kinds as a practice of the skills they are learning.



Horse Camp

Other Info: Bring a bag lunch. Pack sun protection (sunscreen, hat, etc.) and water bottle. Jeans or long pants and closed-toe shoes are required. Masks Required.

Description: All levels are welcome, from youth who have never been on a horse to those that have been riding their entire lives. Each day will be filled with riding and learning the basics of horsemanship skills. Description: Youth will explore concepts of food and kitchen safety and learn how to plan healthy meals using My Plate. Participants will practice kitchen skills and prepare their own lunch everyday.



Basic Shotgun Safety and Skills

Location: Tom Cowden Shooting Sports Range (210 Amberhill Road, Mocksville, NC 27028) **Participants will be picked up and dropped off at the County Center.**

Other Info: Bring Bag Lunch. Wear closed-toe shoes and comfortable clothes. Masks Required

Description: Participants will learn: to safely handle shotguns, to shoot properly, and shoot moving clay targets. Smaller youth should be aware that recoil from the shotguns will be very wearing on the arms. This should be a consideration when signing up for this session.

Description: Participants will learn to safely handle, shotguns, rifles, and bows. This class will cover many topics and be a very hands-on experience. Youth are allowed to bring their own bows but NO other firearms. Smaller youth should be aware that the recoil from shotguns can we wearing on the arm.

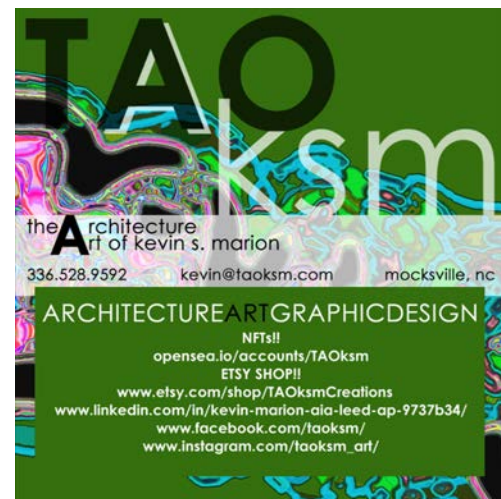
